The Person & Work of the Holy Spirit

This week we examine the gifted leaders of the Church who are called evangelists.

1) The evangelist and his work

"And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some **evangelists**..."

Ephesians 4:11

Using the Blueletter Bible look up the word "evangelists" in Ephesians 4:11 and write down the meaning of the word and what they do.

2) The message of the evangelist

"Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you--unless you believed in vain. For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures..."

1 Corinthians 15:1-4

4)	Both apostles and evangelists preach the Gospel message to the lost; how is an evangelist different from an apostle?
5)	The Bible makes it clear that <u>some</u> believers are given the gift of an evangelist, but additionally that <u>all</u> Christians are to share the Gospel with the lost (ref. Matthew 28:18-20, 1Peter 3:15 & 2Timothy 4:5). Based on your reading so far, and personal observation, how can you tell if a person has the gift of an evangelist?
