


# War with Hamas Is this an End Times Event?

 Any time there is war in the Middle East people wonder if it could be a prelude leading to the Last Days predicted in the Bible.



- In World War I many believed that General Allenby might even be the promised Messiah!
- Each war that the modern state of Israel has fought with her Arab neighbors (1948, 1956, 1967, 1973, 1982, & 2006, has

fueled speculation that we might be on the edge of eternity.



- So it is no surprise that with this latest war against Hamas that many are wondering if this is the beginning of the End...
- ...the final battle when Jesus destroys the wicked & sets up His Kingdom!



- Bottom line...
- We don't know...
- ...yet.
- Rather, we have to wait to see if this war will follow the specific markers predicted in Scripture.
- Additionally, there are three main battles predicted in the Bible so we have to make sure that we're not confusing one with another.
- This evening we'll look at the distinctions between those battles.

# The Three Main Battles of the Last Days

- 1. The attempted **Invasion of Israel** as predicted by Ezekiel.
- 2. The **Battle of Armageddon** predicted in the Revelation.
- 3. The Last Battle predicted in the Revelation.

# **Some Distinctions**

# Timing of the Battle

- The invasion described in Ezekiel 38-39 takes place before the Tribulation (Ez. 38:8).
- The Battle of Armageddon takes place at the end of the Tribulation (Rev. 16:12-16).
- The invasion by Gog & Magog takes place at the end of Millennial Kingdom (Rev. 20:7-10).

# **The Enemy Combatants**

- The confederation of nations listed as combatants in Ezekiel includes only 8 nations who are identified by name; does not include Europe & China (Ez. 38:2-6).
- The combatants in the Battle of Armageddon include the Antichrist and his armies, plus the Kings of the East (China).
- The combatants in the Last Battle are from every nation on Earth.

# The Purpose of the Conflict


- The invaders listed in Ezekiel come to take spoil from Israel.
- The invaders listed in Revelation 16 come to fight with Jesus.
- The invaders listed in Revelation 20 come to dethrone King Jesus.

# **Direction of Attack**

- The combatants in Ezekiel come primarily from the far north.
- The participants in the Battle of Armageddon come from West (Europe) and East (China).
- The combatants in the Last Battle come from every direction from all over the earth.

### **Location of Conflict**

- The conflict in Ezekiel takes place on the East side of the Jordan River in the mountains near the Sea of Galilee.
- The Battle of Armageddon takes place in the Valley of Megiddo on the West side of the Jordan River.
- The Last Battle takes place around Jerusalem.



# Invaders defeated

- Invaders destroyed by one another and by supernatural intervention (flooding rain, hail, & brimstone (Ez. 38:21-22).
- Invaders destroyed by the **Sword of King Jesus' Mouth** (Rev. 19:11-21).
- Invaders destroyed by fire from God (Rev. 20:9).

### Reaction of the World

- At the invasion predicted by Ezekiel the nations, primarily aligned with the West, file a protest but do not act (Ez. 38:22)
- At the Battle of Armageddon no protest mentioned.
- At the Last Battle no protest mentioned.

# After the battle ~ the spoils

- After the invaders listed in Ezekiel 38-39 are destroyed Israel burns the captured weapons as fuel for 7 years (Ez. 39:9-10).
- After the Battle of Armageddon nothing is left of the invading armies (Rev. 19:21).
- After the Final Battle nothing is left of the invading armies (Rev. 20:9-10).

### After the battle ~ the dead

- After the destruction of the armies mentioned in Ezekiel the people of Israel bury the dead on the East side of Jordan River (Ez. 39:4 & 11).
- After Armageddon the A/C & the False Prophet are thrown alive into the Lake of Fire. Those who followed are killed in the Valley & are eaten by birds (Dan. 11:44-45, Jer. 25:33 & Rev. 19:19-21).
- No burial of the dead ~ go immediately to the White Throne Judgement & Lake of Fire (Rev. 20:9, 11-15).

### After the Battle ~ Satan


- No mention of Satan in the invasion predicted by Ezekiel.
- After the Battle of Armageddon Satan is captured & locked into the Bottomless Pit for a 1,000 years (Rev. 20:1-3).
- After the Final Battle Satan is thrown into the Lake of Fire for eternity (Rev. 20:10).

# Clearly these cannot all be the same event! Because...

- Different Times
- Different Combatants
- Different Purpose
- Different Direction of Attack
- Different Location of Battle
- Different Means of Defeat

- Different Reaction from the Nations
- Different Handling of the Spoils
- Different Handling of the Dead
- Different Handling of Satan

# So the attempted Invasion of Israel, the Battle of Armageddon & the Last Battle are three separate events!



# Following the prophetic timeline...

- The next predicted war with Israel will be the one described in Ezekiel 38-39.
- An invasion that includes the nations of Iran, Kazakhstan, Uzbekistan, Turkey, Sudan, Libya, led by Russia.

# The question is...

- Why would Russia get involved leading a group of Muslim nations against Israel?
- Currently the two nations have a good relationship.




### The answer is found in the Bible!

- God tells us in Ezekiel 38:4 that He will "put hooks in your jaws" & drag the "Prince of Rosh" (Russia) into leading the invaders against Israel.
- The question has been, what event or events would draw Russia into an open conflict with Israel?

# One possible "hook"

- If Israel attacks Iran's nuclear labs then Russia would be obligated by treaty with Iran to respond.
- That may be the "hook" that drags
   Russia into a war with Israel.



# Or, Israel may attack Iran because...

- Iran trains, funds, & provides weapons to Hezbollah, Islamic Jihad, & Hamas.
- It is widely believed that Iran "greenlighted" Hamas' recent attack on Israel.




- So Israel may retaliate against Iran directly.
- Once more any attack on Iran would draw Russia into the conflict by mutual assistance treaty.



# Another Reason Russia Would Lead the Invasion

# Because the Muslim nations don't trust Russia!

- The enemies of Israel got burned by Russia in the 1967 War with Israel.
- Next time, they will expect Russia to lead the invasion.










- So, if this war expands to engulf the Middle East...
- And, Israel attacks
   Iran...
- And, Russia responds by leading an invasion...

- Then we're looking at the battle predicted by Ezekiel!
- But we'll have to wait and see.
- We can speculate, but we can't be dogmatic.



- We're not sure that the Church will be here for that event.
- Why?
- Because we're told in Ezekiel that Israel will burn the weapons of the invaders for 7-years...
- Could be a coincidence...

- ...or it could be the same 7-years of the Tribulation!
- If so, & since the Rapture comes before the Tribulation...
- ...it would seem that the Church would be taken home before the invasion of Ezekiel 38-39.

# A Possible Prophetic Timeline

### After the Invasion

The horror of the attempted invasion of Israel will bring the world to the edge of **World War 3...** 

...nuclear annihilation that would destroy the entire planet!

#### Peace!

- The Antichrist will step in to bring the World back from the brink of nuclear holocaust.
- By implementing a
   7-year peace treaty
   between Israel and her
   Muslim neighbors
   (Daniel 9:27).




### **Peace Treaty**

- The incentive for Israel to enter into a treaty may be that the Antichrist will allow Israel to rebuild the Temple.
- A picture of peace between Jews & Muslims.



# How possible is that scenario?

Let me introduce you to...



 A Jewish/Muslim interfaith initiative launched in 2009 that argues building the Third Jewish Temple in Jerusalem would not necessitate the destruction of the Dome of the Rock.  God's Holy Mountain Vision project hopes to defuse religious strife by showing that Jews' end-of-days vision could harmoniously accommodate Islam's present architectural hegemony on the Temple Mount.

#### The Jewish view

 "This vision of religious shrines in peaceful proximity can transform the Temple Mount from a place of contention to its original sacred role as a place of worship shared by Jews, Muslims and Christians," said Yoav Frankel, director of the initiative.

#### Islamic view

- Sheikh Abdulla Nimar
   Darwish, founder of the
   Islamic Movement in Israel,
   said...
- ... "the mahdi will decide whether or not to rebuild the Temple. If he decides that it should be rebuilt, I will go out to the Temple Mount and help carry the rocks."





## Significant because...


**Jewish** Rabbinical traditions says that the **Messiah** will build the next Temple!

Now **Muslim** clerics say they would help build the Jewish Temple if the coming "**Mahdi**", Islams "Messiah", told them to do so.

The coming **Antichrist** may fulfill both Jewish & Islamic traditions!

# The Antichrist would...

 Bring peace to a war-torn world by a
 7 year treaty between Israel & her Muslim neighbors (Dan.9:27).



- The last **7 years** of the "70 Sevens" from Daniel 9.
- Might be a coincidence, but it seems odd that Israel will burn the captured weapons of the invaders for 7 years...
- ...and the treaty brought by the Antichrist is for 7 years.
- And, the Tribulation lasts for 7 years.

- Therefore, many Bible students believe that the Rapture of the Church must take place **before** the invasion described in Ezekiel.
- We can't be sure.

- So we need to stay busy serving the Lord...
- ...with a hand on the plow and an eye on the sky!
