

The Person & Work of God the Son Study 12

In our study this evening we'll continue looking at the names, descriptions and titles the Bible ascribes to Jesus. As we do we will grow in our appreciation of Who He is, which will help us to love, trust, and worship Him more!

1) Son of Man

*"Then I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands, and in the midst of the seven lampstands One like the **Son of Man...**"*

Revelation 1:12-13

Compare John's description of Jesus as the *Son of Man* here in Revelation 1 with Jesus' description of Himself as the *Son of God* in Revelation 2:18. Why do you think John described Jesus as "*One like Son of Man*" instead of using the title *Son of God*?

2) He whose head and hair were white like wool

"His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow..."

Revelation 1:14a

Read Daniel 7:9-14. Why do you think the description of the Father (*the Ancient of Days*) in Daniel is similar to John's description of Jesus in the Revelation?

What do you think the white head and hair represent?

3) He who holds the seven stars

*"To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, 'These things says **He who holds the seven stars** in His right hand...'"*

Revelation 2:1a

Compare this verse with Revelation 1:12-20; according to Jesus what do the seven stars represent?

Why is it significant that the seven stars are in Jesus' right hand, and what do you think it means?

4) He who has the sharp two-edged sword

“And to the angel of the church in Pergamos write, ‘These things says He who has the sharp two-edged sword...’”

Revelation 2:12

Compare this verse with Revelation 1:16 and Hebrews 4:12; what aspect of Jesus’ nature does this title/description of Jesus represent?

Compare the original Greek word for “sword” in Hebrews 4:12 with the Greek word for “sword” in Revelation 2:12. Why do you think the Holy Spirit used two different words to describe the same aspect of Jesus?

5) Son of God

“These things says the Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet like fine brass:”

Revelation 2:18

Read Matthew 8:28-29; in this verse who recognized Jesus as the Son of God?

Read John 10:33 & John 19:6-7; why did the Jews want to crucify Jesus?

How would you use these Scriptures to prove to a cult member that Jesus is more than just a human being?

6) Who has eyes like a flame of fire

“These things says the Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet like fine brass:”

Revelation 2:18b

Compare this description/title of Jesus to Hebrews 4:13. What divine attribute do you think Jesus’ “eyes like a flame of fire” represent and why?
