

## The Person & Work of God the Son

### Study 13

We ended our last study with this description of Jesus; “*Who has eyes like a flame of fire,*” reminding us that Jesus is watching His Church and that nothing is hidden from His sight. We pick up our study with another unusual image of the glorified Christ, Whom John tells us has “*feet like fine brass.*”

#### 1) Feet like fine brass

“These things says the Son of God, who has eyes like a flame of fire, and  
**His feet like fine brass:**”  
Revelation 2:18b

Much of the symbolism used in the Revelation comes to us from the Old Testament. To understand what brass feet represent we have to look back at the Tabernacle in the Wilderness—which is earthly model of the Heavenly Throne Room (Exodus 25 & Hebrews 8:5).

Read Exodus 38:21-30: What was the gold used to build in the Tabernacle?

What was the bronze (brass) used to build in the Tabernacle?

What do you think the gold and bronze are symbolic of?

What do you think the description of Jesus’ feet “like fine brass” represent?

#### 2) He Who has the seven Spirits of God

“These things says **He who has the seven Spirits of God...**”  
Revelation 3:1a

Admittedly this description of Jesus is a bit confusing because we know that there is only One Holy Spirit, but here we’re told there are “*seven Spirits of God.*” To help us understand this description let’s compare this verse with Isaiah 11:1-2.

Who is the “Rod” and the “Branch” that Isaiah describing in vs. 1?

Notice that Isaiah tells us that the “*The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him.*” What future event in Jesus’ earthly life is Isaiah foretelling?

Now list the seven different Spirits enumerated in Isaiah 11:1-2:

3) He Who is holy

*“These things says He Who is holy...”  
Revelation 3:7a*

Compare with 1 Peter 1:15-16; Why is it significant that we’re told that Jesus *is* holy?

4) He Who is true

*“He who is true...”  
Revelation 3:7b*

Compare with John 14:6 & 18:37; In what sense is Jesus true?

4) He Who has the key of David

*“He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts  
and no one opens”  
Revelation 3:7c*

Compare with Isaiah 22:20-22; what door can Jesus open & shut that no one else can?
